# Introduction:

This year we challenge participants to harness the power of innovative technology methods to address real-world challenges and contribute to sustainable development. This competition invites creative thinkers and researchers to utilize cutting-edge technology and creative research expertise to develop design solutions that align with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), which can make a meaningful difference in social, technological and sustainable environments.

Participants are invited to choose one of the following United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) as the focus of their design solution. You can choose to submit either an ongoing project or completed project in professional or academic environments:

- 1. No Poverty
- 2. Zero Hunger
- 3. Good Health and Well-being
- 4. Quality Education
- 5. Gender Equality
- 6. Clean Water and Sanitation
- 7. Affordable and Clean Energy
- 8. Decent Work and Economic Growth
- 9. Industry, Innovation, and Infrastructure
- 10. Reduced Inequality
- 11. Sustainable Cities and Communities

#### Deliverables:

Participants are required to submit up to two A2 boards in PDF format. There can be a maximum of four group participants per submission. On the first A2 board you are required to include:

- 1. All participant(s) names
- A short paragraph explaining the design concept and how it responds to one of the SDGs goals
- A clear and concise design outcome where the design outcome includes but not limited to diagrams, drawings and render visualisation. Videos are acceptable but optional.

## **Judging Criteria:**

Entries will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Alignment with SDGs: The design solution addresses one or more of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
- 2. Innovation and Creativity: The originality and creativity of the proposed design solution and its approach to addressing the identified problem.
- Practicality and Applicability: The practicality and applicability of the proposed solution in real-world scenarios, considering factors such as feasibility, scalability, and potential for impact.
- 4. Presentation and Clarity: The clarity, coherence, and professionalism of the project proposal, design concept, and technical specifications.

Winners will receive cash prize and the opportunity to connect with our pioneering jury panel and discuss their ideas further.
